4. 대화를 듣고, 그림에서 남자가 찾는 책이 위치한 곳을 고르시오.

M: Excuse me, I'm looking for some picture books of reptiles.

W: They're in the oversized book section.

M: Could you tell me how to get there, please?

W: Sure. First, take the elevator to the third floor. Then turn left and go straight to the Internet search desk.

M: Turn left and go to the Internet search desk. Okay. And then?

W: Turn right at the corner, and go straight. The picture books are located in the second section on your right.

5. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Have you ever been invited to social gatherings you didn't want to attend? If you've experienced this situation, you may know how difficult it is to reject the invitation. But sometimes turning it down can be the only realistic solution because of a busy schedule or personal reasons. You can use the following tips to refuse an invitation politely and respectfully. First, understand why you were invited and thank the person who invited you. Then show regret that you're not able to attend, and let the person know that you would accept the invitation under different circumstances. Cards and gifts can also be good ways to smooth the situation over.

6. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 주장으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Mom, this remote control doesn't work.

W: Also, when you eat a lot of fish that have mercury inside, it can damage your brain.

M: That's really scary. Now, I understand why the batteries should be thrown out separately.

Then, soak the stained fabric in the water for half an hour. If the stain is still visible after soaking it, try rubbing alcohol into it. Then, the ink stain will be gone. By following this method, you can easily remove these annoying stains.
